

## RevoSet® compatible ,multi use‘ reset-chips for toner cartridges HP 207AX / 216A / 415AX / 59A / 59X

### 1. Specifications of ,multi use‘ chips

- ✓ Small square design - like the original chip. These **RevoSet®** reset chips are used in original and compatible toner cartridges 207AX / 216A / 415AX. Each type of toner uses different reset chips, but the installation and settings in the printer menu are comparable.
- ✓ Once the toner cartridge is empty, you may simply refill toner powder without having to change the chip. Alternatively you may purchase a low-cost compatible toner cartridge without a chip and insert that chip there.
- ✓ Using this reset-chip, there will be no remaining pages shown on the display.
- ✓ The printer will report that a used cartridge or a “not original” cartridge has been inserted. Please confirm this message by accepting it ("OK").

### 2. Settings to be made in the printer menu

- **„Cartridge Policy“** must be deactivated. In order to do so, please navigate using the arrow buttons and the „OK“ button on the panel:
  - SETUP
  - Supply settings
  - Cartridge Policy **„OFF“**
- **„Cartridge Protection“** must be deactivated. In order to do so, please navigate using the arrow buttons and the „OK“ button on the panel:
  - SETUP
  - Supply settings
  - Cartridge Protection **„OFF“**
- If on your printer model there is a menu item like **„Seriously out of consumables“**, this has to be set to **„Continue“**.
